JUDGING: Three judges are required. One serves as chairperson to check the math of the other judges and figure the total score for each child. Judges should mark only mistakes on the score sheet. The chairperson averages the number of errors for each child and subtracts from 24 to determine each child's score.

MISTAKES:

- Child fails to step out within 10 seconds.
- Child gives an incorrect response. This includes any child who raises a hand, indicating an error.
- Child fails to stand straight or keep eyes on the drill caller until the "Start" command is given.
- Child steps forward before the index finger is on the correct response (when the Bible is used.)
- Child fails to handle the Bible according to instructions or obviously mishandles the Bible. The Bible should be held parallel to the floor with one hand flat on top, one hand flat on the bottom, with no fingers extending over the edges.
