Feeding at some sites has completed. Chainsaw crews will continue along with volunteer management and other services to the community.

10-15 smaller feeding sites are being established across the affected area to serve residents and volunteers.

CHURCH AND MINISTRY STAFF ASSESSMENTS AS OF 10/8/2024:
